Al Anima

The practice is trialling the use of AI Anima which is a scribing tool to help GPs run to time and focus on the patient. All transcriptions are checked for accuracy before being saved to the notes. Your doctor will ask for your consent to use this so if you do not want them to, let your doctor know.
